Notification of procedural decision

I write to inform you that, in relation to the notice given by the applicant of the upcoming compulsory acquisition hearing commencing Tuesday 30 September 2014, the Panel has made a procedural decision to direct the applicant to carry out its duties in accordance with Rule 13(6) of the EPR no later than 15 September 2014.

Rule 13(6) states that unless the Examining authority otherwise directs, the applicant must not later than 21 days before the date fixed for the commencement of a hearing, in summary, post and maintain a notice of the hearing in a conspicuous place and in places where public notices are usually posted in the area and publish a notice of the hearing by local advertisement in the area. By undertaking its these duties on 15 September 2014 the applicant provides 14 days notice before the date fixed for the commencement of the hearings.
