  - 1.4.a revised Book of Reference (Application document 4.3);
  - 1.5.revised Land Plan 7A of 18 (Application document 2.1); and

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

2. that the Examining Authority accepts the following amendments to the Application, in each case subject to submission of amended application documents in due course:
  - 2.1. the exclusion of Work No. 8 (UV Treatment Works);
  - 2.2. noting the election of TLSB to promote an engineering solution for temporary cofferdam construction (Work No. 2b) using sediment/Geotubes® and rock armour; and
  - 2.3. the exclusion of Option B as the location of the turbine and sluice gate housing structure contained in Work No. 2a.
