Thank you for sending through this information regarding the non material change to the Dogger Bank Teesside A & B DCO.

The above consultation does not involve any change to the environmental assessment as was used to inform examination and decision to grant consent for both of these projects.

We are aware of the other non-material change to the DCO(s) consultation which is presently on-going (this is mentioned in the covering letter), but this appears to be further non-material amendments regarding the delivery of these two projects as two legally separate consented developments, so it does include both the onshore cable corridor and seabed development aspects to clarify responsibilities between the two developers i.e. Sofia is to be built by Innogy Renewables UK Ltd. and Teesside A (or as it is now known, Dogger Bank C) by SSE and Equinor.

We therefore acknowledge receipt and offer no comments.
