Dear Professor Glasson,

As you will be aware, E.ON E&P UK Limited ('E.ON E&P') has submitted relevant and written representations in relation to the proposed Hornsea Offshore Wind Farm Phase 2 DCO (the 'Scheme').


As E.ON E&P's relevant and written representations set out, there is a significant overlap between the Scheme and its interests. While discussions continue, E.ON E&P's concerns in relation to this overlap are yet to be resolved with the Applicant.

In its letter of 15 July 2015 accompanying its written representation, E.ON E&P indicated its intention to attend the Issue Specific Hearing on 15 September. E.ON E&P has now had sight of the agenda for this hearing and notes that there appears to be no specific item to deal with the concerns it has raised.

It is E.ON E&P's view that its representations raise important issues relating to the deliverability of the Scheme, therefore it intends to attend the Issue Specific Hearing on 15 September and would be grateful if it could be heard under the agenda item most convenient for the Examining Authority. Item 4.4 may be appropriate but we would be grateful if you would confirm the Examining Authority's view.
