Thank you for your email.

The CAA do not plan to attend the preliminary meeting but note the requirements for a Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) concerning radar effects, impacts, mitigation and management listed at Annex G of the Planning inspectorate letter. The CAA are in the process of discussing the SoCG with the developer and note the deadline of 15 July 15.

The CAA also note the Principal Issue relating to aviation being local airport/airstrips impacts and radar issues, however would state that it is the responsibility of individual airport and Air Navigation Service Providers to safeguard their own operations and make representations if necessary.

It should also be noted that any impact on military aviation should be addressed to the MOD and would be covered by their own SoCG which has also been requested in Annex G.
