Hornsea Offshore Wind Farm Project Two ("Project Two") Onshore Infrastructure Crossing – Virgin Media.

We provide fixed and mobile telephone, television and broadband internet services to businesses and consumers in the United Kingdom. We are a statutory undertaker pursuant to The Electronic Communications Code (Conditions and Restrictions) Regulations 2003 (as amended).

We understand that you are planning to install infrastructure relating to Project Two (the "Project Two Infrastructure") over, or in close proximity to, elements of our telecommunications network (the "VM Network").

We acknowledge that you are in the process of obtaining the relevant statutory consents for Project Two. As part of this process, assurances are required from us that we approve in principle to the Project Two Infrastructure being laid over, or in close proximity to, the VM Network.

We further acknowledge that you have engaged with us in respect of Project Two during the pre-application and post application process both in terms of informal non-statutory engagement and formal consultation carried out pursuant to the Planning Act 2008.

We confirm that the provisions set out in the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991, and The electronic communications code ("the code") as set out in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984 as amended by Schedule 3 to the Communications Act 2003, provide adequate protection for the VM Network.

Therefore, we can advise that we do not intend to participate in the examination process for the Development Consent Order for Project Two as legislative provisions are already in place.
