The draft permit for SHCHP has been sent to the applicant for comment, we will then consult the public again ( PPD with just press statements and online due to low public interest on the 1<sup>st</sup> consultation process).

The SHLNG variation is with our permitting team and we will shortly send the draft variation to SH LNG. PPD is not considered to be needed for this as it only relates to reductions of aqueous emissions to the SAC from the LNG process. This gave “room” for the CHP plant emissions to be discharged without any change to the load on the SAC. The maximum total load from the two activity remains at < 50 Kg/day of Nitrogen against a total load to Milford Haven of c 6000Kg/Day of Nitrogen.

On 7 October, we wrote to PINS, copied to DECC, advising that we would be willing to consider assisting DECC in appraising any submission by the applicant of an 'extent and severity' overview.

We have reviewed the position and consider we have provided helpful and sufficient advice (particularly with our resources being stretched as they are).

We note the Applicant (a large multi-national consortium) is using a specialist risk contractor to prepare its assessments. If the Applicant requires further assistance in preparing its assessments, then it should seek that from the market place.

The timing of approval for any submission is a matter for DECC. However, it would seem sensible this happens after DCO has been granted but before construction begins.


I trust you recognise our reasons for limiting our involvement in this matter and hope you find the advice we have offered to be helpful to you.
