Thank you for consulting us on the above proposal.

Historic England has access to a GIS system which holds data on designated historic features (except conservation areas), but does not show non-designated aspects of historic interest. In order to obtain a comprehensive overview of all historic resources within the study area, you are therefore strongly advised to contact the relevant Historic Environment Record and the Local Authority Conservation Officer (who will be able to confirm the presence and extent of conservation areas). For large-scale schemes we recommend that the English Heritage Archive at Swindon should be contacted.

Based on the information provided on the proposal, and a review of the GIS dataset (World Heritage Sites; Scheduled Monuments; Registered Parks and Gardens; Registered Battlefields; Listed Buildings), there are no designated features within the study area.
