Sir,

I take this opportunity to respond to the below request, with particular reference to Examiners question no 8.

In respect of the questions raised I can confirm that there remain outstanding issues from a WWU operational perspective and from a National Security viewpoint. The basis of the same have already been set out in correspondence.

By way of progress I can advise that we continue to move forward. We have now consulted with and received comments from our Director and Asset Integrity Manager. I can advise, on a without prejudice basis, that while this has not resulted in any material objections to the proposals it is to be stressed that it remains a critical element of this proposal to ensure that there is no negative impact on our plant, infrastructure and our Security Upgrade Project, which is part of a National Security Regime.

Details of this security regime are still being finalised, with particular reference to design and finalised location. We continue to work with our security consultants and it is anticipated further details will be with us shortly. The date for finalisation of such details has now been agreed as 21/2/2017. In the meantime we continue to strive to put this in place if at all possible prior to this date.

Once this is finalised we can review the detail here referenced to Wrexham Energy specific proposals. This in turn may necessitate a request to them for additional updated design plans and elevations of the proposed offtake and consideration of any possible site boundary adjustments, which in turn is proposed can be reviewed at a joint site meeting. This can extend to a discussion referenced to the Draft Protective Provisions at that time. In the meantime, and following discussion with WWUs General Counsel, it is proposed that we will be looking to appoint external legal consultants to review and comment on such proposed provisions and this in turn will form the basis on meaningful and ongoing liaison with Wrexham Energy.
