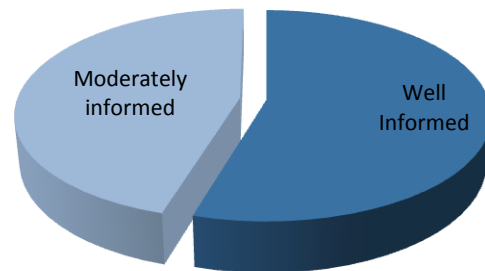

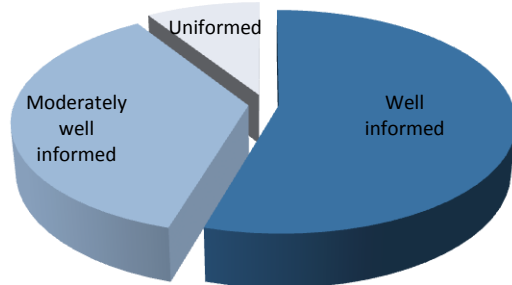


18.1.2 How well informed do you feel you are in respect of East Anglia THREE/ FOUR offshore windfarm?

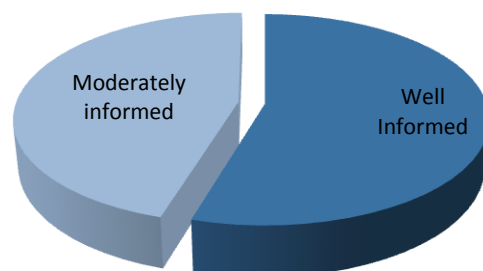

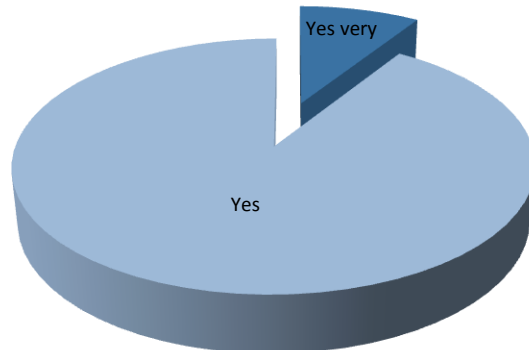
