### **East Anglia Offshore Windfarm - Maritime Traffic Survey**

Dear Sir,

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce you, if you were not already aware, to East Anglia Offshore Wind; a joint venture company comprising of ScottishPower Renewables and Vattenfall Wind Power.

East Anglia Offshore Wind was awarded the rights to explore developing a portion of seabed in the southern North Sea for offshore wind. As part of the consenting process for such a development we are obliged to undertake a Navigational Risk Assessment (NRA) of the area as per MGN 371. To facilitate this, our consultants Anatec, undertook a second vessel traffic survey in May of this year in the area of our proposed project - East Anglia THREE

During the survey one of your vessels (**M/V xxxx**) was identified transiting the area more than once. We are committed to engaging with all stakeholders that may be affected by our developments. To that end we would like to draw your attention to the development and associated Scoping Reports. The Scoping Reports set out our approach to development of East Anglia THREE and the Navigational Risk Assessment. Links to the Scoping Reports can be found at [www.eastangliawind.com](http://www.eastangliawind.com). Further material regarding both the zone and individual projects will be uploaded to this site as and when it becomes available.

Throughout the course of this year ScottishPower Renewables and Vattenfall Wind Power will undertake further traffic surveys and complete the NRA. Under the UKs Planning Act 2008 we are legally obliged to consult with stakeholders on our proposals; to that end we will be in touch next year. The below PINS advice note 8.1 explains the process and how you can get involved.
