**East Anglia THREE Offshore Windfarm: Section 42 consultation**

Dear Mr Wilks,

East Anglia Offshore Wind Limited (EAOW) would like to thank you again for taking the time to provide a response to the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR) for the East Anglia THREE Offshore Windfarm during last summer's consultation.


We wrote to you in September 2014 to explain that our timescale for making the application (including the production of the Environmental Statement and the drafting of the Development Consent Order) had changed and that we would inform you of the new date for the application in due course. Our intention now is to submit the application in November 2015.

As you are aware from discussions with the project team, since the PEIR consultation, Scenario 1, in which ducts will be installed during East Anglia ONE construction to accommodate the East Anglia THREE cables, has been chosen as the preferred method for cable installation. Therefore the installation of the cables for East Anglia THREE will only involve the construction of jointing pits, a haul road and the pull through of cables. There will no longer be the requirement to excavate trenches along the full cable route to install the East Anglia THREE cables.

There have also been some refinements to the project design to take account of the change in the funding system through the Contracts for Difference (CfD). EAOW will include in the Development Consent Order application the potential to build East Anglia THREE in two 600MW phases, which reflects the CfD changes. These changes have been included in the Phase III report published for the Section 42 Consultation. This consultation period ends 23<sup>rd</sup> July
