The Proposed East Anglia THREE Offshore Windfarm Order

The Planning Inspectorate (on behalf of the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change) has accepted an application made by East Anglia THREE Limited (the **Applicant**) of 3rd Floor, 1 Tudor Street, London, EC4Y 0AH, a ScottishPower Renewables company, for a development consent order under the Planning Act 2008 (the **Application**). The Application was made on 18 November 2015 and accepted for examination on 15 December 2015 (reference: EN010056).

The Application is for development consent to construct and operate the proposed East Anglia THREE Offshore Wind Farm, which comprises up to 172 wind turbine generators and associated infrastructure, with an installed capacity of up to 1,200 MW (the **Project**).

Please find enclosed a DVD containing a copy of the following:

- a) Map showing the location of the proposed development;
- b) The completed and signed Application form;
- c) The Environmental Statement; and
- d) Each other document listed on the enclosed Schedule.

A Notice of the accepted Application has also been provided in hard copy with this letter.
