Sections 102A and 89 of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended)

Request to become an Interested Party to the proposed East Anglia Three Offshore Wind Farm under S102A of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended)

Thank you for the request you submitted to us on 13 July 2016 to become an Interested Party to the application for the proposed East Anglia Three Offshore Wind Farm ('the application'), under section 102A of the Planning Act 2008 (PA2008).

Your request has been considered by the Examining Authority, which has decided that it does not consider you to be a person within one or more of the categories set out in section 102B of the PA2008, so your request does not meet the criteria set out within section 102A of the PA2008. You have, therefore, not become an Interested Party.

However, the Examining Authority, in the exercise of its discretion:

1. Has decided to accept your representation dated 13 July 2016 into the examination of the application; and
