Notice is hereby given that a Preliminary Meeting and an Issue-Specific Hearing into the definition of the project and the draft Development Consent Order will be held by the Examining Authority for the examination of the application made by East Anglia THREE Limited (the **Applicant**) of 3rd Floor, 1 Tudor Street, London EC4Y 0AH for a Development Consent Order under sections 14, 15 and 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the **Application**). The Application was made on 18 November 2015 and accepted for examination on 15 December 2015 (Reference: EN010056).

Notice of any further hearings will be publicised as appropriate following confirmation of the Examination timetable. The Application relates to the construction and operation of an offshore wind farm within the East Anglia Zone of the North Sea (the **Project**). The proposed wind farm is approximately 69km from the coast at Lowestoft, Suffolk at its closest point to land. It will connect to the National Grid via underground cables to the substation at Bramford, Suffolk.

The Development Consent Order would, amongst other things, authorise:

- up to 172 offshore wind turbines and associated foundations, with an installed capacity of up to 1,200 MW;
- Up to two meteorological masts and foundations;
- Up to twelve buoys;
- Up to six offshore electrical stations;
- Up to one offshore platform housing accommodation facilities;
- Subsea inter-array cables between the wind turbines and offshore electrical stations;
- Up to four subsea export cables to transmit electricity from the offshore electrical stations to shore;
- Up to four interconnector cables between the East Anglia ONE and East Anglia THREE Projects;
- Scour protection around foundations and on inter-array and export cables as required;
- Landfall at Bawdsey with onshore transition bays to join the offshore and onshore cables;
- Up to four onshore underground circuits (each containing up to three cables) pulled through existing ducting to be laid by East Anglia ONE or directly laid, running for approximately 37 km from landfall to the connection point at Bramford, Suffolk, with jointing pits, to transmit electricity to up to two new onshore substations;
- Up to two onshore substations at Bramford, Suffolk, to connect the offshore wind farm to the National Grid;

- The permanent and / or temporary compulsory acquisition (if required) of land and / or rights for the proposed Project;
- Overriding of easements and other rights over or affecting land for the proposed Project;
- The application and / or disapplication of legislation relevant to the proposed Project including inter alia legislation relating to compulsory purchase; and
- Such ancillary, incidental and consequential provisions, permits or consents as are necessary and / or convenient.

The proposed works are environmental impact assessment (EIA) development for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009 and accordingly an Environmental Statement accompanied the Application.

The Applicant agrees to the examination and operation of the offshore wind farm within the East Anglia Three Project. The proposed wind farm is sited in the North Sea, off the coast of Suffolk, England. It will consist of the National Grid (NG) cables and the substation at Ipswich, Suffolk.

- The Development Consent Order will, amongst other things, authorize:
1. Up to 176 offshore wind turbines and associated foundations, with an installed capacity of up to 1,200 MW;
 2. Up to two meteorological masts and foundations;
 3. Up to three jetties;
 4. Up to six offshore electrical substations;
 5. Up to one offshore platform housing accommodation facilities;
 6. Subsea inter-array cables between the wind turbines and offshore electrical substations;
 7. Up to four subsea export cables to transmit electricity from the offshore electrical substations to shore;
 8. Up to four inter-array cables between the East Anglia OCS and East Anglia THREE Project;
 9. Seven permanent coastal foundations and onshore array and export cables as required;
 10. Landfill at Ipswich with various treatment steps to join the offshore and onshore cables;
 11. Up to four onshore underground cables (each consisting up to three cables) placed through existing ducting to be used by East Anglia OCS or directly laid, running for approximately 37 km from Ipswich to the connection point at Ipswich, Suffolk, with joining pits to connect electricity to up to two new onshore substations;
 12. Up to two onshore substations at Ipswich, Suffolk, to connect the offshore wind farm to the National Grid;
 13. The purchase and / or temporary compulsory acquisition (if required) of land and / or rights for the proposed Project;
 14. Granting of easements and other rights over or affecting land for the proposed Project;
 15. That applications and / or discharge of obligations relevant to the proposed Project including (but not limited to) compulsory purchase and;
 16. Such ancillary, incidental and consequential provisions, powers or covenants as are necessary and / or appropriate.
