First of all, we would like to thank you for the French version of the non-technical summary of the environmental statement. I'm sure that this document will help us to understand better this initiative, so if you have any other relevant document (especially in French) about this topic, could you please forward us these documents.

During the last weeks, we received from the French Minister of the Environment a statement about the East Anglia Three Offshore windfarm project. Because this is a major topic, our Minister decided to set up a public consultation (i.e enquête publique) in the département of Nord and département of Pas-de-Calais, based on the article R.122-10-II about transboundary consultation, from the French Environment Code.

In the same spirit of your « Code of practice on consultation », we need a couple of weeks to launch the consultation, to conclude the process and to sum up the various results (ref French Environment code - Book I, Title II, Chapter III).

We are trying now to quickly begin this consultation and we will inform your service as soon as the process will start. Please be sure that we're doing our best to provide at your department a satisfactory answer on this relevant topic.
