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Letter from EAONE to Secretary of State

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Dear Sirs

The East Anglia ONE Offshore Wind Farm Order 2014 (as amended by the East Anglia ONE Offshore Wind Farm (Corrections and Amendments) Order 2016 ("the Order")) Requirement 35 - Transmission System

We are writing on behalf of East Anglia ONE Limited (EAOL).

As you will be aware, Requirement 35 of the Order states as follows:

Transmission system

35.—(1) *Prior to commencement of construction of the authorised development, the undertaker must give written notice to the Secretary of State, the relevant planning authority and the MMO detailing the selection made by the undertaker under Work No. 1 to construct either the HVDC offshore wind farm, using the HVDC option, or the HVAC offshore wind farm, using the HVAC option.*

(2) Where under sub-paragraph (1) the HVAC option is selected, the written notice shall also specify whether the HVAC collector stations are to be constructed under Work No. 1(b) or Work No. 2.

(3) The authorised development must be constructed using either, wholly, the HVAC option or the HVDC option and no combination of the two is permitted.

"HVAC option" is defined as *"the sub-sea export cables in Work No.3A and the connection works between the HVAC offshore wind farm and the connection point at the existing National Grid Bramford substation by way of a HVAC transmission system."*

"HVAC offshore wind farm" is defined as *"a wind turbine generating station with a gross electrical output capacity of up to 750MW comprising up to 150 wind turbine generators."*

We shall be grateful if you will treat this letter as notice for the purposes of Requirement 35 (1) and (2) of the Order that EAOL has selected to construct the HVAC offshore wind farm using the HVAC option and that the HVAC collector stations will be constructed under Work No.2.

We can also advise that the HVAC offshore wind farm will comprise of one hundred and two, seven megawatt turbines.

We are also sending a copy of this letter to the Marine Management Organisation and to the relevant local planning authorities, Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils, Suffolk Coastal District Council and Suffolk County Council.

We shall be grateful if you will confirm receipt of this letter and that this letter provides all the information which you require for the purposes of Requirement 35.
