Dear Sirs

Further to our response sent earlier this morning by Katherine Potts, and for the purposes of clarity, I have been asked by the applicant to confirm that the LPAs do not raise objection to the definition of 'commence' within the DCO as;

"commence" means:

(a) in relation to works seaward of MHWS, the first carrying out of any licensed marine activities authorised by the deemed marine licences, save for pre-construction surveys and monitoring; and

(b) in respect of any other works comprised in the authorised project, beginning to carry out any material operation (as defined in section 155 of the 2008 Act) forming part of the authorised project other than operations consisting of site clearance, demolition work, archaeological investigations, environmental surveys, investigations for the purpose of assessing ground conditions, remedial work in respect of any contamination or other adverse ground conditions, diversion and laying of services, erection of any temporary means of enclosure, the temporary display of site notices or advertisements, save that site clearance works landward of MHWS and archaeological works within Work Number [XX] shall first have been notified to the relevant planning authority for confirmation that the works do not constitute commencement and that either the planning authority has confirmed that the works do not constitute commencement or having identified in writing that a further 10 working days are required to

make such a decision. In the event that no response is received by the undertaker within 5 working days of such notification then the works shall be construed not to constitute commencement within the terms of this order”.

Please therefore accept this email as acceptance of the definition as drafted above.
