Please accept this email as a joint response from Suffolk County Council, Suffolk Coastal District Council and Mid Suffolk and Babergh District Councils to the questions posed in the ExA Consultation Draft DCO. We set out our response to the questions as follows:

- **Definition of Commence and the need for pre-commencement works**

We are content that the notification process is currently working well for the EA1 project and that we have the option to send a holding response if unable to respond within 5 days.

We support the wording of the Applicants proposed new Requirement 37.

- **Definition of ‘maintain’**

We are content with the applicants suggestion on wording – including the word “upkeep”

- **Detailed design parameters onshore**

We have no objection to the ExA’s suggested new form of words

- **Included documents**

We agree that it would be beneficial to add a Project Environmental Management Plan to the list of plans in the provision

- **Possible missing requirement – Skills Strategy**

We are content with the approach agreed in the position statement on skills between SPR and SCC. We have now met with colleagues at IBC who are also content with this approach.
