RE: The East Anglia Three Offshore Wind Farm Order 2017 – Formal consultation on Proposed Non-Material Change Application

Thank you for your consultation request dated 25th March 2019 on the Proposed Non-Material Change Application for The East Anglia Three Offshore Wind Farm Order 2017.

The Marine Management Organisation has an interest in any proposed changes to Development Consent Orders (DCOs) for Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIPs) in the marine area as the MMO is responsible for monitoring, compliance and enforcement of Deemed Marine Licence (DML) conditions.

The MMO also received application for a Variation to the DML on this non-material change dated 22nd March 2019. This request is currently under consideration.

The MMO as the regulatory body for the DMLs will consider a variation to the DMLs in parallel with the consideration of the non-material change application undertaken by the Secretary of State (SoS) for the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS).

The MMO will endeavour to align its processes with BEIS and requests copies of all the consultation responses in this matter.
