
We welcome the reduction in the number of turbines and the increase in tip height but given the increase in rotor diameter we would like to see the collision risk modelling results.

East Anglia Three Limited (EATL) submitted an Application for Development Consent and associated Deemed Marine Licences for the East Anglia THREE Offshore Wind Farm in November 2015, with consent granted by the Secretary of State for the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) in August 2017. The East Anglia THREE Offshore Wind Farm Order 2017 (2017 Order) granted consent for the development of an offshore wind farm with a gross output of 1,200 Megawatt (MW) (1.2 Gigawatt (GW)), located 69 km off the coast of Suffolk. The 2017 Order consented up to 172 wind turbines and associated offshore infrastructure. The East Anglia THREE Offshore Wind Farm (Correction) Order 2018 was subsequently granted on 12 July 2018 to correct certain errors in the 2017 Order. EATL submitted a successful non-material change in 2019 in which amendments to the maximum generating capacity was granted from 1,200MW to 1,400MW.

In order to benefit from continuing technological developments in the offshore wind industry, some elements of the EA THREE design envelope, as secured in the 2017 Order (as amended) require amendment. We have undertaken a review of the proposed amendments, current consent and EIA documentation and have concluded that the amendments represent a non-material change to the DCO. EATL therefore intends to submit an application for a non-material change to the 2017 Order (as amended) in relation to the offshore works associated with the East Anglia THREE Windfarm.

The amendments relate to parameters associated with the wind turbine generators (WTG) and offshore substations (OSS) and importantly, include a significant reduction in the maximum number of both WTG's and OSS being installed. Please find attached a brief set of slides that we shared with BEIS recently that outlines the changes. The work carried out on the proposed amendments has concluded that these proposed amendments will not result in any changes to the conclusions of the EIA.

We have informed BEIS of our intention to submit a non-material change application and intend to submit the Regulation 7 notice identifying the list of consultees to BEIS by early next week. It is our intention to include the RSPB in the Regulation 7 list of consultees that we intend to formally consult with on the application. I am therefore writing to you to confirm our intention to submit the relevant supporting information to you for comment around mid-June.

In advance of submitting the non-material change documentation, please let me know if you have any initial questions or want to discuss further and we can organise a call to discuss. Please let me know if you think this would be of benefit, and I can facilitate this.
