## Non-Material Change Application to East Anglia Three Offshore Windfarm Order 2017

On 16 July 2020 the Marine Management Organization (MMO) received notice that East Anglia Three Offshore Windfarm Limited (EATL) have submitted a Non-Material Change application to The Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) to make changes to the East Anglia Three Offshore Windfarm Order 2017. The changes to the Development Consent Order (DCO) as amended are in relation to the offshore works for East Anglia Three Offshore Windfarm only.

Thank you for providing a providing a direct response to our concerns raised in our letter to BEIS dated 30 September 2020.

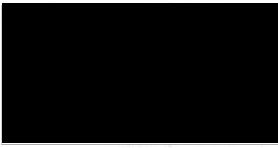
The MMO have reviewed the response and have the following comments.

1. The MMO note that EATL plan to cascade the answers to the various questions regarding assurances around scour protection into the various reports required before final construction can start. For instance, the Construction Method Statement, the Scour Protection Management, and Cable Protection Plan documents are all referenced. Whilst the design envelope is still large, this seems an appropriate route. However, once the design envelope is finalised, a thorough review of the volumes of scour protection, and evidence that they are within the scenarios assessed in the Environmental Statement, will be required.
2. The MMO request one final clarification on the calculations provided; do EATL expect to drill to the same depth if using a 10m or 12m diameter monopile?

The MMO are content that EATL have addressed the concerns raised in our previous correspondence and are satisfied with the proposed non-material changes to the East Anglia Three Offshore Windfarm Order 2017.
