Following our conversation yesterday, I attach the Errata for the Consultation Report (doc ref 5.01) submitted with the above application. The 2 main corrections are:

1. The letter at Appendix 6 of the report should be replaced with the letter dated 23 January 2014 attached to the Errata.

This letter is sent to you as part of a statutory consultation exercise carried out pursuant to section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 ("the Act"). Tata Steel UK Limited ("Tata Steel") is consulting you in your capacity as a prescribed consultee under Schedule 1 to the APFP Regulations and/or a consultee under section 42 of the Act.

Tata Steel intends to submit an application for the above-mentioned Order that would authorise the construction, operation and maintenance of a process-gas fired electricity generating station on the site of Tata Steel's steelworks at Port Talbot, South Wales. The proposed development would increase the electrical generating capacity of the site by up to 130 MW, providing a total capacity of up to 225 MW. As the generation capacity of the proposed development exceeds 50 MW, an application for a Development Consent Order ("DCO") is required under the Act.

Under Section 42 of the Act, Tata Steel is required to consult with the prescribed list of bodies set out in Schedule 1 to the APFP Regulations, and with host and neighbouring Local Authorities and those who have an interest in the land affected by the proposed application.

The development to which the proposed application relates is "EIA development" for the purposes of the EIA Regulations. Tata Steel has produced a Preliminary Environmental Information Report ("PEIR") which contains preliminary information about the likely environmental effects of the proposed development, together with a non-technical summary of this information. Further environmental studies and assessments are being undertaken, and a full environmental statement will be produced and submitted with the proposed application.


