I can confirm that South Staffordshire District Council were consulted on 5th June 2014 as an adjoining Local Planning Authority under section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 by Meaford Energy Limited. The consultation ran until 7th July 2014. The consultation documents included a brochure on Meaford Energy Centre and its connections; a Preliminary Environmental Information Report: Non-Technical Summary and letter covering the following points:

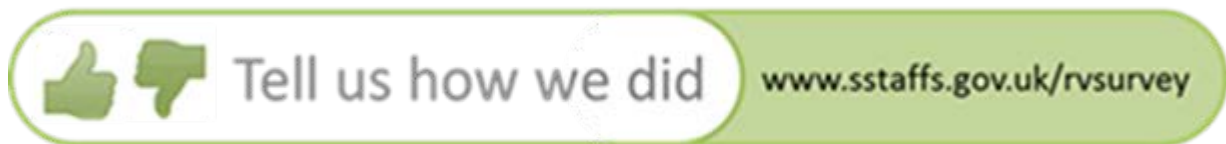
