Further to our telephone conversation today I confirm our discussions and the representation made to the inspector at the preliminary meeting yesterday. WPD would like to accompany the inspector on his site visit of the development site. We think it would be useful for one of WPD's representatives to show the inspector WPD's assets adjoining and crossing the site. These consist of two substations and numerous overhead electricity lines/pylons and poles. Some lines are also underground and these can be identified to the inspector by way of an assets plan at the site visit.

It is not necessary for the inspector to actually enter onto any land owned by WPD as the two substations can be viewed from outside of the compounds but within the development site.

I trust that this is helpful clarification.
