Proposed Changes to the Original Application

On the 11 July 2018 the Applicant submitted a request to change its original Application. The details of these proposed changes are the following aspects of the Application:

• An amendment to the Order limits and plots 4_PGP and 5_PGP. This comprises of Work No.2A in Schedule 1 of the draft DCO Revision 3.

I am now inviting comments on these changes, and will need to consider whether these represent material changes to the Application that was the subject of public consultation and the Environmental Impact Assessment.

The Application documents and cover letter, which explains the changes and submitted by the Applicant for Deadline 5 on 11 July can be viewed on the Millbrook Power project page:

To assist me in my consideration of these changes, I would welcome comments on them, and in particular on whether they represent a material change to the application such that I should not accept them.



Sheet 1 of 3 in the Land Plans (Revision 1) submitted at Deadline 5 (J0008128-101 RevG) shows the revised plot 4_PGP. It notes that *"In respect of Plot 4_PGP the Applicant seeks a right of access of no more than 15 metres in width during construction and the right to construct, use and maintain a permanent access road of no more than 10 metres in width."*

Question for the Applicant - Please will the Applicant explain why it is seeking powers of compulsory acquisition over the whole of revised plot 4_PGP which appears to be larger than is required to provide the proposed access route?
