Characteristics of the Development	<p>The proposed development would comprise:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A new power generation plant in the form of a Simple Cycle Gas Turbine (SCGT) gas fired peaking power generating station fuelled by natural gas and capable of providing and electrical capacity of up to 299 MW comprising: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The generating equipment including the gas turbine generators and balance of plant • A new purpose built access road either from the Rhyd-y-pandy Road to the north (Access Road – Option 1) or the B4489 to the west (Access Road – Option 2) • A temporary construction compound (the Laydown Area) • A new gas connection to bring natural gas to the generating equipment from either the National Transmission System (NTS) or the Local Transmission System (LTS), which is located within the gas opportunity area; • A new electrical connection to export power from the generating equipment to the National Grid Electricity Transmission System (NETS) for distribution to homes and businesses which is located within the gas connection opportunity area; • As a peaking plant (required to operate when there is a surge in demand) the generating equipment would operate for up to 1500 hours per year;

Geographical area	The applicant has not indicated within their Scoping Report whether any impacts are likely to extend beyond the jurisdiction of the UK.
Location of Development (including existing use)	<p>The site is located within the City and County of Swansea. The agricultural land classification for the land within and surrounding the proposed site is grade 4 (poor quality agricultural land) and is dominated by improved grassland fields used for grazing sheep and horses. In addition within the proposed site, is a disused coal mine, a landfill as well as small areas of marshy grassland and woodland copses interspersing the improved grassland to the north and east.</p> <p>The site lies approximate 8 km from Wales West coast and the Bristol Channel.</p>
Cumulative impacts	<p>The Scoping Report identifies the following developments for inclusion within the cumulative assessment to be undertaken as part of the Environmental Statement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Planning Application 2013/0795 – Installation of four 5 kW wind turbines 120.7 m to tip and associated infrastructure at Myle Coch Mawr; • Planning Application 2013/0135 – Installation of ground mounted array of solar panels, inverter substations and 2.4 m high fencing on land at Abergelli Farm. This development would be located within the gas connection opportunity area on the proposed site; • Planning Application 2013/1639 (Rhyd-y-pandy Solar Park) – Construction of 7 MW solar park consisting of installation of up to 28,250 photovoltaic panels and up to six inverter/transformer cabins, a single control building and provision of security fencing; • Proposed development within the Swansea Vale Development Area and other developments, should information become publically available in time to allow inclusion. <p>Section 4.3 of the Scoping Report deals with the cumulative assessment.</p>
Carrier	Potential pollution via air, land and water.
Environmental Importance	The three designated European sites that lie within 10 km of the proposed site are Burry Inlet Ramsar Site and SPA, Carmarthen Bay and Estuaries SAC and Crymlyn Bog Ramsar Site and SAC. Two SSSI's and one LNR lie within 5km of the proposed site, there are 23 SINC's within 2 km of the proposed site.

	<p>The nearest AONB is the Gower which is remote from proposed site and is visually separated by intervening topography.</p> <p>Cultural Heritage and Archaeology are dealt with within section 5.10 of the Scoping Report. <p data-bbox="97 271 1500 324">Transboundary re-screening undertaken by the Inspectorate on behalf of the SoS</p> <p data-bbox="97 324 1500 443">Following submission of the DCO application which included the Environmental Statement and the Applicant’s NSER arising during examination, the Inspectorate has reconsidered the transboundary screening decision made in July 2014.</p> <p data-bbox="97 443 1500 638">The Inspectorate notes that changes have been made to the Proposed Development the subject of the DCO application since the previous transboundary screening decision was made on 18th July 2014. However, the Inspectorate considers that the changes will not result in significant effects on the environment in another EEA State, and therefore the conclusion remains unchanged from that in the previous transboundary screening decision.</p> <p data-bbox="97 638 1500 689">The changes noted in the DCO application are summarised below:</p> <ul data-bbox="159 689 1500 1176" style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="159 689 1500 808">• The SCGT Power Generation Plant (c.2.65ha) is to be made up of a single Gas Turbine Generator and exhaust stack, as opposed to the potential 5 listed in the original application. <li data-bbox="159 808 1500 860">• The maximum height of the exhaust stack has been increased by 5m, to 45m. <li data-bbox="159 860 1500 943">• The Power Generation Plant has been relocated and is to be sited to the north of the existing Welsh Water Main. <li data-bbox="159 943 1500 994">• An access route from the B4489 to the west of the site has been selected. <li data-bbox="159 994 1500 1077">• An option has been selected (Option B) for a new section of access road (in addition to the route presented in the 2018 PEIR report). <li data-bbox="159 1077 1500 1176">• The electrical connection now runs parallel with the road, as opposed to running under it. <p data-bbox="97 1176 1500 1473">The transboundary screening of the Proposed Development has been considered taking into account the transitional provisions in Regulation 37 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 (the 2017 EIA Regulations). The Applicant requested the SoS to adopt a scoping opinion in respect of the development to which the screening relates prior to 16 May 2017 (the date of the commencement of the 2017 EIA Regulations).
