Request for Further Information

Transport for London (TfL) submitted a written representation dated 23 March 2016 which set out at paragraph 3 an objection to compulsory acquisition of TfL's freehold land interests. This position was reaffirmed as part of the Local Impact Report submitted by the GLA dated 22 March 2016. I have taken these representations to constitute an objection by TfL to the compulsory acquisition of new rights for landscaping purposes and access improvements concerning plots 24, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 31 in TfL's freehold ownership.

At the compulsory acquisition hearing held on 6 July 2016, the representative from BDB (Mr Angus Walker) indicated on behalf of TfL that the interest extended to a much larger number of plots within the Order land, namely the compulsory temporary suspension and extinguishment of rights concerning variously plots 7, 8, 11, 13, 17, 18, 19, 22, 23, 25, 30 and 34. This is reaffirmed in the submission from BDB dated 15 July, 2016. I conclude therefore that the objection from TfL to compulsory acquisition proposals is more wide ranging than those plots listed in the previous paragraph.

From the TfL Statement of Common Ground dated April 2016 (paragraph 4.14) and paragraph 2.2.2 of the submission from BDB dated 15 July 2016 on behalf of TfL, I appreciate that discussions about proposed compulsory acquisition powers are taking place with the applicant. I would be grateful therefore for a statement of the final position of TfL by deadline 8 of the examination timetable,

22 August 2016, confirming whether the outstanding objection to compulsory acquisition of TfL's interests in these various plots in the Order land is maintained or withdrawn.
