Request for Further Information

The Lee Valley Regional Park Authority's Statement of Common Ground dated April 2016 includes at section 3.14 comments about the property negotiations, which could be interpreted as an objection to proposed compulsory acquisition of the Authority's land interests. I have taken this to cover the applicant's proposed acquisition of new rights for landscaping purposes and access improvements concerning the Authority's freehold ownership of plots 15 and 21. I assume that the Authority has no objection to the temporary suspension of its rights concerning plots 11, 12, 13, 16, 17, 22, 23, and 24.

From the a joint statement on negotiations for private agreement between the applicant and the Authority dated 25 July 2016, I appreciate that provisional agreement has been reached on the granting of a lease, but this and the discharging of the Authority's objection is subject to a formal decision by Members of the Authority. I would be grateful therefore for a statement of the final position of the Lee Valley Regional Park Authority by deadline 8 of the examination timetable, 22 August 2016, confirming whether the outstanding objection to compulsory acquisition of the Authority's interests in these various plots in the Order land is maintained or withdrawn.
