**Application for a Non-Material Change to the North London Heat And Power Generating Station Order 2017 (S.I. 2017/215) (“Order”) under section 153 and paragraph 2 of Schedule 6 to the Planning Act 2008 and the Infrastructure Planning (Changes To, And Revocation Of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011 (“2011 Regulations”)**

North London Waste Authority (“NLWA”) hereby applies for a non-material change to the Order (“Application”), as set out in this letter and its enclosures (submitted in triplicate).

The Application seeks to increase the maximum cap on electrical output of the Energy Recovery Facility (“ERF”) at Edmonton EcoPark from 70MW<sub>e</sub> to 78MW<sub>e</sub>. This increase in electrical output will not result in an increase in the 700,000 tonnes maximum annual throughput of waste at the ERF. The Application does not propose any further changes to the Order. No new compulsory acquisition powers are sought as a result of this Application.

In order to support the Secretary of State's consideration of the Application and in accordance with regulation 4 of the 2011 Regulations, we enclose copies of the following documents outlined below.
