North London Heat and Power Generating Station Order 2017 (SI 2017/215) – Non-Material Change Application

I refer to the above application submitted by the North London Waste Authority.

I note the application for a Non Material Change to the North London Heat and Power Generating Station Order 2017 (the DCO) to amend Schedule 1 of the DCO to allow an increase in the maximum electrical output from 70 to 78 megawatts of electricity (MWe (gross)), to allow for increased electrical generation, which may arise from the burning of waste with fluctuating calorific values and/or improved energy efficiency. No change is proposed to the maximum volume of waste that the incinerator can process – 700,000 tonnes per year. The application confirms that there would be no additional environmental effects caused by generating an additional 8MWe of electricity from time to time, given that the amount of waste used to fuel the Energy Recovery Facility will remain unchanged. The application also confirms that the proposed change will have no impact on habitats or protected species, and no impact on either businesses or residents in the locality. NLWA also confirm that the application does not seek to amend any compulsory acquisition powers already within the DCO.
