Dear Sir,

In response to the ExA's second written questions and request for further information under "Section 4. Landscape and visual impacts, good design", namely

"4.1 SNPA

*Further to its comments in the SoCG with the applicant [REP3-009, D7], is SNPA content that the draft DCO [REP4-009, Requirements 20 and 22] (**Should this read Requirement 19?**) secures the mitigation required for potential impacts on dark sky status due to light overspill"*

The Snowdonia National Park Authority is satisfied that Requirement 19 of the Draft DCO along with statements in the ES (Chapter 15 "Environmental Management And Chapter 17 "Summary of Mitigation") – see below - will ensure that the effects of proposed scheme's lighting on Snowdonia's Dark Skies Reserve status will be minimised.

19.

(1) Not less than three months before commissioning any phase of the authorised development, the undertaker must submit to the relevant planning authority written details of all external lighting to be installed at that phase of the authorised development, and such details must be in accordance with the environmental statement and the design and access statement and must include details of the direction and levels of lighting.

(2)The relevant phase of the authorised development must not be brought into Operation until the details submitted under sub – paragraph (1) have been approved by the relevant planning authority and the approved external lighting scheme has been installed. (3) Subject to requirement 24 the approved lighting scheme must be retained and Complied with for the duration of the operation of the relevant phase of the authorised development.

(Draft DCO)

Lighting

15.5.15 At night and during periods of darkness directional security lighting will be used.

15.5.16 As stated in the T&CPA decision notice the Development must conform to the requirements of the Obtrusive Light Limitations for Exterior Lighting Installations for each respective Environmental Zone in the area.

(ES Chapter 15)

During night and periods of darkness directional security lighting will be used. To minimise impacts on Environmental Zones in the area, the Development will conform to the requirements of the Obtrusive Light Limitations for Exterior Lighting Installations as stated in the T&CPA decision.

(ES Chapter 17)

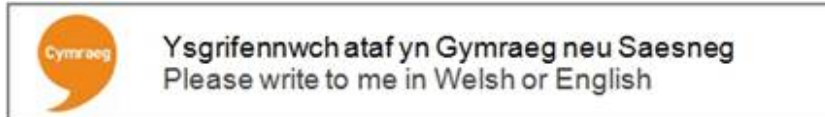

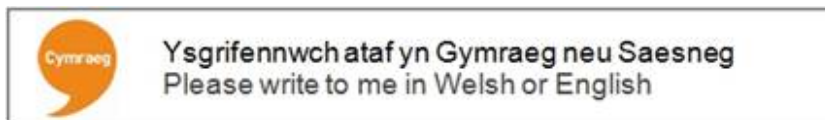
