NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO MAKE A NON-MATERIAL CHANGE TO THE FOLLOWING DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER:

THE GLYN RHONWY PUMPED STORAGE GENERATING STATION ORDER 2017 (SI 2017/330) AS CORRECTED BY THE GLYN RHONWY PUMPED STORAGE GENERATING STATION (CORRECTION) ORDER 2017 (SI 2017/969) AND AMENDED BY THE GLYN RHONWY PUMPED STORAGE GENERATING STATION (AMENDMENT) (WALES) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Snowdonia Pumped Hydro Limited ("SPH") of 35 Ballards Lane, London, N3 1XW, to the Welsh Ministers to make a non-material change to the Glyn Rhonwy Pumped Storage Generating Station Order 2017 (as corrected by the Glyn Rhonwy Pumped Storage Generating Station (Correction) Order 2017) and amended by the Glyn Rhonwy Pumped Storage Generating Station (Amendment) (Wales) Order 2021 ("the Order") under the Planning Act 2008 ("the Application").

The Order grants development consent for the construction and operation of a pumped storage facility consisting of upper and lower reservoirs, pipe, a power house, pumping station, spillways and ancillary development with an output of 99.9 megawatts at Glyn Rhonwy and Chwarel Fawr quarries, near Llanberis, Gwynedd, Wales.

The Application seeks to make a non-material change to the time limit for commencing construction by amending Requirement 2 of Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Order due to unprecedented increases in construction costs associated with post Covid inflationary factors, and ongoing work on energy policy for support of Large-scale Long-duration Energy Storage. The time limit for commencing construction stated in Requirement 2 of the Order is 29 March 2024. The proposed non-material change is to extend this time limit by 2 years so that the deadline for commencing construction will be 29 March 2026.
