I am writing to express my objection to the proposed extension of the planning permission for the project referred to above granted to Snowdonia Pumped Hydro. I live on Ffordd Cefn Du in Waunfawr and if construction goes ahead the residents and road users of this area will be severely affected by dangers from construction traffic, noise and dust pollution. This road is considerably busier now than when permission was originally granted to SPH.

SPH have already had an extension of 2 years to the then deadline date of 29 March 2022. They blamed the Covid Pandemic for their inability to comply with the initial deadline.

They are now asking for another 2 years blaming "unprecedented increases in construction costs associated with post Covid inflationary factors"

I feel that we will be in this same position in another 2 years because SPH will still have no developer and insufficient investors as the cost for this development will only increase further and will become even more unviable.

The Planning Inspectorate has already set a precedent for granting time extensions and I suggest that this application is refused now and put an end to this process becoming an ongoing saga.
