Please find below my response on behalf of Suffolk County Council.

Written submissions on Examination procedure responding to matters raised orally in the Preliminary Meeting Part 1.

In response to you comments made at PM 1 and to the recent agenda for OFHs1-3 published by the ExA, SCC does not envisage needing the 10 minutes available for 'organisations' for its contribution and that its points can be more succinctly expressed in about 5 minutes.

Furthermore I would like to indicate that SCC fully acknowledges and welcomes the indication given by the ExA that it will be invited to all relevant Issue Specific Hearings which address its areas of concern (as set out in its Relevant Representation), and recognises that those ISHs will be the appropriate place for the presentation of its detailed comments.

Nonetheless SCC considers that it is important, at an early stage of the Examination(s), for its Cabinet Member, with over-arching responsibility for environmental matters, to be able to outline to the Examination(s), in headline terms, the key areas both of support and concern in relation to the proposals, so that the ExA is fully sighted on those matters from the highest level of SCC.
