I am writing on behalf of my mother, a [REDACTED] resident of [REDACTED] Sizewell [REDACTED], acting as her Power of Attorney who is an Affected person in this enquiry. The proposed SPR cable corridor crosses our land. I have previously made known my strong objections to this proposal on a number of grounds, not least the potential damage to the aquifer beneath this house whose waters supply the well on which we and four other properties rely. SO far we have had no mitigation for that risk.

We write to endorse SEAS, SASES, Save Our Sandlings, The Aldeburgh Business Association and Friston Parochial Church Council, formal objection letter of 8 April to the Examination extension.

The applicants' pockets are deep and an extension will fall very heavily financially on local individual objection. Not only is this financially burdensome but prolongs the acute mental anguish and uncertainty that local residents are feeling. All along the Examining Authority gave scrupulous extra time for all members of the public to make known their objections or concerns. Granting an extension such as this clearly favours the applicant whose pockets are deep.

I ask the Examining Authority to reconsider this extension, the consequences of which fall unequally on objectors and applicants.
