The following constitutes Natural England's formal statutory response for Examination Deadline 10.

1. Natural England Deadline 10 Submissions

Natural England has reviewed the relevant documents submitted by the Applicant at Deadline 9. We would like to highlight to the Examining Authority that only new documents (version 1) or revised versions of outline documents/plans where amendments have been formally made will be responded to by Natural England at each relevant Deadline. 2. Risks and Issues Log

Natural England thank the Applicant for their comments on our Deadline 8 Risk and Issues log [REP9-017]. We have taken some comments in this document into consideration when updating the Deadline 10 version.

Following notification of the extension to the examination timetable, Natural England has reviewed the presentation of the Risks and Issues Log. As such, the log submitted at Deadline 10 is truncated to reflect only the outstanding risks and issues, as represented at Deadline 9 and 10.

Moving forward, this will enable the outstanding risks and issues to be tracked during the remainder of the examination.

Please note, as all items associated with marine mammals are considered resolved, this section of the risks and issues log is removed in entirety.
