I write to object to the applications for;

1. 1.East Anglia One North Offshore Wind Farm (EA1N),
2. 2.East Anglia Two Offshore Wind Farm (EA2),
3. 3.Nautilus Interconnector,
4. 4.Eurolink Interconnector, and now
5. 5.Sea Link Interconnector.

The magnitude of the proposed developments will cause irreparable damage to the environment which is a beautiful and rare ecological habitat designated as both an AONB and SSRI. The impact such a project will have a hugely negative impact on the environment, affecting not on the natural ecology but also the human cost will be significant and blighting.

The cumulative impact this proposal as well as the Sizewell C proposal is tragic to contemplate. The only sensible conclusion is that such infrastructure must be sited elsewhere at a less sensitive brownfield site, if at all. There must be better and greener alternatives to our future than this
