**SUBMISSION OF KITTIWAKE IMPLEMENTATION PLANS UNDER PART 1 OF
SCHEDULE 18 TO THE 2022 ORDERS**

1. On 14 March 2024, ScottishPower Renewables (“the Applicant”) submitted a Kittiwake Implementation and Monitoring Plan (“the KIMP”) to the Secretary of State for Energy Security & Net Zero (“the Secretary of State”) under Part 1 of Schedule 18 to the East Anglia ONE North Offshore Wind Farm Order 2022 and the East Anglia TWO Offshore Wind Farm Order 2022 (“the Orders”).

6. This letter is without prejudice to the Secretary of State's consideration of whether to approve the Plans. Nothing in this letter is to be taken to imply what the eventual decision might be or what final conclusions the Secretary of State may reach on any particular issue.
