Further to my email of 6th March I have changed my mind and would like to ask the following question:-

"OFGEM's recent Decarbonisation Action Plan stated that individual radial offshore transmission links are not economic, sensible or acceptable to local communities.

OFGEM stated that there should be offshore cable loops to minimise onshore construction and disruption.

This strategy would make the Friston proposal unnecessary..

In view of OFGEM's initiative will the Planning Inspectorate suspend this enquiry pending an agreement between OFGEM and BEIS on future strategy for onshore development."
