

Detailed Agenda

The allocation of persons to each Agenda item is based on the Examining Authorities' (ExA's) understanding of topics which people wish to raise, and where such topics fit best into the Agenda. The ExAs hope that this proves useful and provides further clarity to attendees, as well as helping to make the PM run as smoothly and efficiently as possible.
