Re; Comment on ESC and SCC joint local impact report on EA1N and EA2.

A brief note to comment that TSC broadly agrees with the comments on tourism that the two councils make in their joint local impact report.

However the TSC's tourism impact survey, carried out by leading consultants BVA BDRC and which is referred to in sections 20.14 and 20.25, concluded that the negative impact of the two SPR projects and Sizewell C could be £24m - £40m per annum. In the two councils' report the impact figure is given as £20m and then as £24m. The Planning Inspectorate are asked to note that the negative impact could be considerably worse than £20m - £24m.
