**Application by East Anglia ONE North Limited for an Order Granting Development Consent for the East Anglia ONE North (EA1N) Offshore Windfarm project; and  
Application by East Anglia TWO Limited for an Order Granting Development Consent for the East Anglia TWO (EA2) Offshore Windfarm project**

### **Outline Operational Drainage Management Plan**

We have reviewed the Outline Drainage Management Plans submitted at Deadline 4 for both EA1N and EA2 (Doc. Ref. ExA.AS-1.D4.V2, Dated 13 Jan 2021).

We are satisfied that, for issues within our remit, the documents form a broadly appropriate basis for the Operational Drainage Management Plan required under Requirement 41 of the draft DCO. We note that pollutant removal measures are to be considered in accordance with the requirements of the CIRIA SuDS Manual. We also note that the first preference for foul drainage disposal will be to the mains system, but that this will be further discussed with us. We are satisfied with these proposals.

We would however take this opportunity to offer a couple of minor points of correction.

Section 2.3.4 refers to a series of Pollution Prevention Guidance notes (PPGs). Footnote 2 highlights that PPG1 was withdrawn in 2015. In fact, all the PPGs listed were withdrawn in 2015; but it is acknowledged that they may still be considered to provide useful guidance.

Section 3.5, paragraph 38 suggests that updated Environment Agency data on groundwater source protection zones has caused the secondary aquifer underlying the site to be reclassified. This is not the case and the aquifer designations remain as previously described.
