As District Councillors and Ward Members for the area most affected, together with my fellow Cllr T-J Haworth-Culf, we would again like to thank the Inspectorate for the opportunity to feed into the process and for assisting those with less accessibility to more easily take part.

We would like to support the very balanced representations made by the various communities and Societies who have taken the time to consult and subsequently convey their views at the Open Floor Hearings. We remain reassured that the views given orally are given equal weight to those presented as written representations, and are confident in the ongoing process of the Examination.

The Norfolk Vanguard High Court decision to quash the SoS' decision on the proposed development is one we strongly welcome; the in-combination effects of this / these application(s) in many respects more than mirror the position of the Norfolk proposal. The current combined energy applications attracted threaten to swamp this area and gravely affect the prosperity and quality of life both here and in the surrounding area.

Of the Issue Specific Hearings 9 (ISHs9): Hearings Action Points, in particular we support 'arbitration clause to be amended to ensure public openness and transparency where possible' included in point 2.

We look forward to further engagement with town and parish Councils any other community representatives/ civil society organisations as in point 5 of the current 'Hearings Action Points' and note the D8 deadline; an important aspect of representing and enabling in particular the most closely affected communities to ensure their voices are heard.
