Dear Inspectorate panel,

Please see attached the map to support part of my D6 submission, which will follow this email. Referring to proposed archaeological dig and survey in the area surrounding Wardens, plots 10 and 13. Each coloured line represents an extensive trench, and deep boreholes are also indicated.

I am alarmed to find that this pre-consent survey is proposed to start in March, next month, and continue into 2022, and forms part of the contract and NDA that Dr Gimson has made the subject of a serious complaint regarding the conduct of the Applicant.

The area of the map, plots 10 and 13, also features heavily in my D6 Biodiversity submission, as part of the plots 10;12;13;14 report on species currently living in the area. Quite apart from the devastation that the overall SPR project would unleash on this protected eco-system, the commencement of trenching depicted in the photograph, and associated works, would in and of itself be catastrophic for many species, and involve permanent destruction of many natural habitats.

I respectfully submit that this archaeological survey is wholly unjustified and unnecessary prior to consent, and suggest furthermore that it serves no other genuine purpose than the attempted acquisition of land rights to be sold on or sub-let, together with the much-noted dog-leg curve towards the Wardens Centre itself, to the multiple other companies which will be seeking landfall points between Ness House and Dower House (eg National Grid Interconnectors, as now renamed, with plans published to local councils)
