Outstanding Biodiversity & HRA Issues Deadline 7 Submission

Dear Mr Rynd Smith and Examining Authorities

Due to shortness of time between deadline 6 and 7 and following on from our submission of 24 February, ^{1 2} SEAS would like to remind the ExA of the following outstanding points, which we hope will be addressed in more detail at the ISH14 on from SEAS submission

- 1.The Applicant has not addressed the problem of the important hedgerows in Aldringham and Coldfair Green, such as those that bound **both** sides of Fitches Lane. These boundaries are historic, and the hedgerows and their biome are around 2 centuries old.
- 2. SEAS is concerned at the lack of proper mitigation, and lack of scope for mitigation, for Area 19, Fitches Lane, and the all ancient hedgerows in the area. Treating a parallel hedgerow as a single hedgerow is not acceptable.
- 3. SEAS remains unsatisfied with the issue of Works Area 19. The Applicant says the woodland is not wet, yet lists numerous species there that prefer wet and riparian conditions.
- 3.1 SEAS has presented further evidence of the woodland's wet status at deadline 6, and our record of species are (also) in accordance with a wet woodland.
- 4. SEAS is concerned that the catch, or drain, fed by the river within work area 19 has not been fully assessed by the Applicant as a location for aquatic forms of invertebrates, like the hairy dragonfly.
- 5. SEAS is concerned that the mitigation for protected species in arable fields is also not adequately addressed.
