I am writing on behalf of Wardens Trust Wardens Hall, Sizewell IP16 4UB, which is an Interested Party in this enquiry

The proposed SPR cable corridor borders the Trust's property and we have consistently objected to the cable route which we argue is an existential threat to this charity. Thus far we have had no mitigation for those risks.

We write to endorse SEAS, SASES, Save Our Sandlings, The Aldeburgh Business Association and Friston Parochial Church Council, formal objection letter of 8 April to the Examination extension.

The applicants pockets are deep and an extension will fall very heavily financially on local individual objections. Not only is this financially burdensome but prolongs the acute mental anguish and uncertainty that local residents and organisations are feeling and freezes any possibility of future planning.

All along the Examining Authority gave scrupulous extra time for all members of the public or Interested Parties to make known their objections or concerns. Granting an extension such as this clearly favours the applicant whose pockets are deep.

I ask the Examining Authority to reconsider this extension, the consequences of which fall unequally on objectors and applicants.
