Objection to Extension of Examinations

Further to my letter of 14th April I feel I must place on record my objection to the extension to the decision to extend the examinations by three months, as notified by the Planning Inspectorate to Interested Parties.

Not only does it prolong the suspense and agony experienced by the residents of this unique and beautiful area but it also gives SPR an unfair advantage in that they have unlimited resources to continue feeding information into the process whereas we, individual residents and small groups, have more-or-less burned ourselves out in terms of the energy, time and financial input devoted to building a case against the badly thought out proposals by SPR.

The signs erected last week in Friston alerting pedestrians to 'be aware' seemed to deliver a sinister warning - 'hazards ahead and beware of SPR's dangerous and slippery driving.' The whole process smacks of intimidation and bodes ill for the future.
