**East Anglia TWO Limited (the “Applicant”)**  
**The Proposed East Anglia TWO Offshore Windfarm Order**

**Request for a Change to the Order Limits at Work No. 9 (Plot 13)**

We refer to the Applicant’s cover letter at Deadline 9 where the Applicant gave advance notice of their intention to request a change to the Order limits for Work No. 9 at Plot 13. Through further engagement with the Project’s design teams, the Wardens Trust, Natural England and other relevant stakeholders, the Applicant has been able to revise the alignment of the onshore cable corridor to provide an increased separation distance between the onshore cable corridor and the Wardens Trust property, whilst maintaining an appropriate separation distance from the Sandlings Special Protection Area (SPA) and avoiding any additional interference with Eastern Power Networks’ existing overhead lines in the vicinity.

Full details of the change, together with an overview of the consultation carried out in respect of the change and consideration of the environmental implications of the change are provided within the enclosed **Change Request: Amendment to Order Limits at Work No. 9 (Plot 13)**. The Applicant has also enclosed the following documents to support their request:

Whilst additional land is proposed to be included within the Order limits, there are no new affected persons. Furthermore, the Applicant has consulted with the affected landowner and has obtained the landowner's consent to the inclusion in the Application of provisions authorising compulsory acquisition of the additional land. The Applicant has also obtained the consent of Eastern Power Networks which is an existing affected person and which has a right of access over the additional land. The Applicant therefore does not consider that the requirements of Regulations 5 to 19 of the Infrastructure Planning (Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010 (the CA Regulations) apply as all persons with an interest in the additional land have consented to the inclusion of provision within the draft DCO authorising compulsory acquisition of the additional land.

The Applicant requests that the Examining Authority accepts the change to the Order limits for Work No. 9 for Examination.
