Please accept this letter as confirmation that we have been appointed to act on behalf of our client Aldeburgh Golf Club, in respect of the examination of the above applications.

Aldeburgh Golf Club who have already made representations to the applications are a significant landowner (please see enclosed estate plan) located at the western edge of Aldeburgh with Golf Courses on either side, north and south of Saxmundham Road (A1094), linking Friston to the Coast.

The club object to the proposals due to the impact the construction and operation of these major development projects will have on:

- The sensitive, protected heathland landscape, which the Club in part is an important steward of recognised by winning the national Environmental Golf Course of the Year Award in 2019.
- Traffic impacts, with projected increases in traffic movement leading to congestion and safety concerns for members and visitors accessing the Clubs courses.
- Economic impacts with the effects of the development highlighted above having a significant negative impact on the attractiveness of the area with consequent decline in visitor numbers to the area and a serious economic impact on the Club.
